

Federal: Recovery Strategy within 2 years

** GCLCA s. 12.8.32c - The Board has the power to approve plans for the management of endangered species.

SPECIES STATUS DEFINITIONS

Species of Special Concern: A species that may become threatened or endangered because of a combination of biological characteristics and identified threats.

A species that is likely to become endangered if nothing is done to **Threatened Species:** reverse the factors leading to its extirpation or extinction.

A species that is facing imminent extirpation or extinction. **Endangered Species:**

Extirpated Species (NWT): A species that no longer exists in the wild in the Northwest Territories but exists in the wild outside the Northwest Territories.

> A species that no longer exists in the wild in Canada but exists in the (Canada): wild outside Canada.
