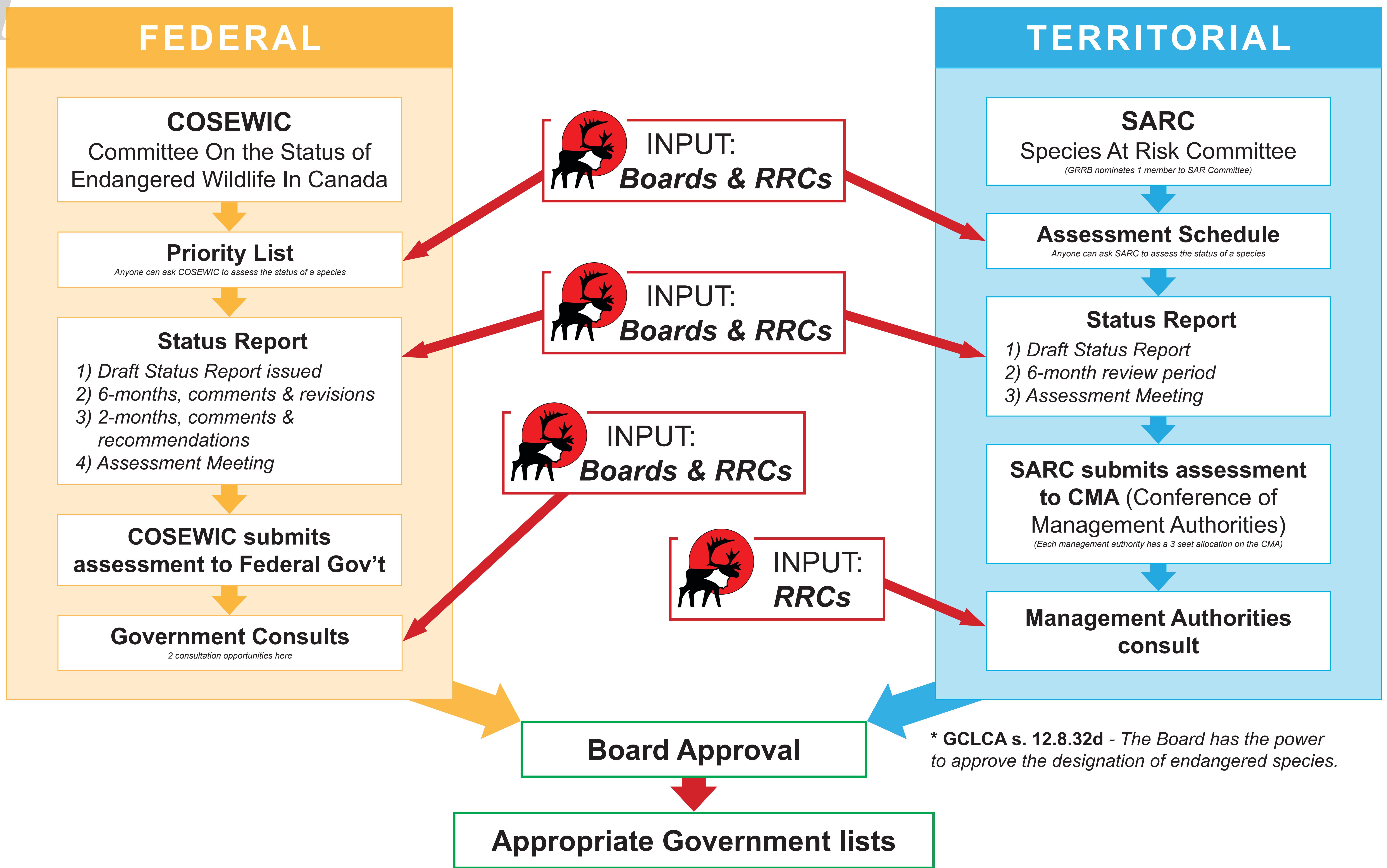
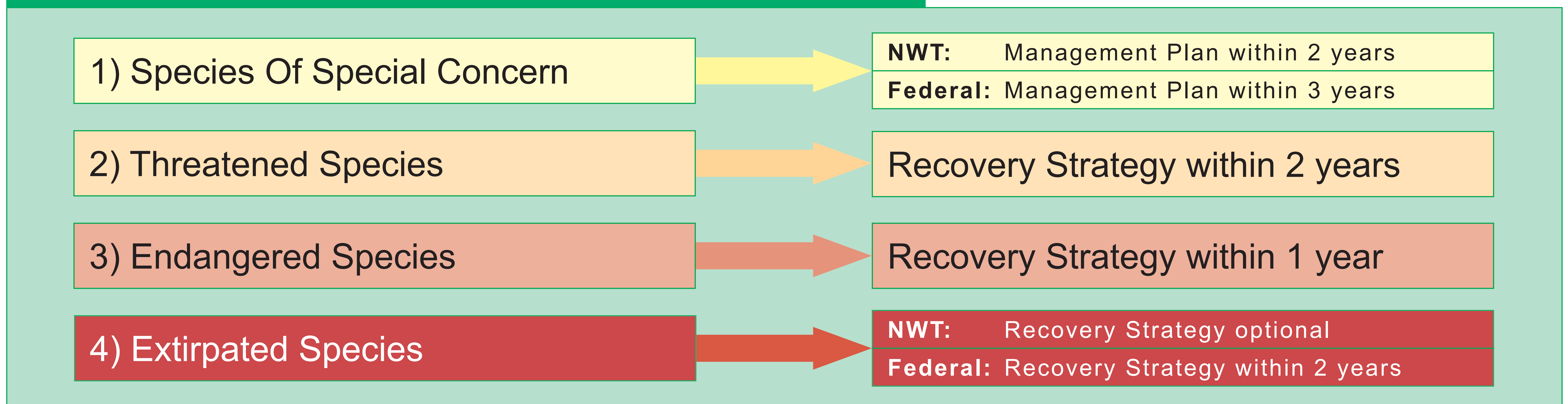


SARA Process (Species At Risk Act)

SPECIES STATUS DEFINITIONS

Species of Special Concern: A species that may become threatened or endangered because of a combination of biological characteristics and identified threats.

Threatened Species: A species that is likely to become endangered if nothing is done to reverse the factors leading to its extirpation or extinction.

Endangered Species: A species that is facing imminent extirpation or extinction.

Extirpated Species (NWT): A species that no longer exists in the wild in the Northwest Territories but exists in the wild outside the Northwest Territories.

(Canada): A species that no longer exists in the wild in Canada but exists in the wild outside Canada.
